- Note:** 1. There is a regulatory requirement for stock to have received a preliminary treatment for cattle tick prior to presentation for clearance inspection. The preliminary treatment must be to a standard that should ensure stock are free of cattle ticks when presented for clearance.
2. The maximum penalty for providing false information in this declaration is \$30,000.
