Nomination form - Entries close strictly 21/09/09

EACH NOMINATED ENTRY MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF A REGISTRATION FORM FOR THAT ANIMAL ... FOR IT TO BE ACCEPTED INTO THE SALE. (This will assist our 'cataloging' process immensely.)

Entry Conditions

1. All nominations are subject to inspection by a Sale Committee on property, prior to draw being conducted. Nomination fees on cattle rejected **prior to cataloging** - will be refunded.
2. **All cattle to be vendor bred only.**
3. Order of sale: Joined females, cows and calves, followed by unjoined.
4. Age limits: Cows with calves = maximum 72 months. Joined females 15 - 36 months. Unjoined = minimum 12 months and maximum 24 months. All these ages should be as at sale day.
5. Entries in Cow & Calf section must have calving records listed and have had the first calf by 36 months of age.
6. D3, D4 and D5 cattle ONLY will be accepted.
7. **Cows with calves and joined females to have pregnancy certificates available at the Sale, and be preg tested within 21 days of sale.** Joined females NDP are to be withdrawn, unjoined females to be preg tested NDP within 21 days of sale. Any positives to be withdrawn. Certificates to be available at sale.
8. All cattle to be treated for 3 Germ Tick Fever and 7 in 1, and most importantly, be pre-treated for ticks for easy movement to clean areas.
9. DPI personnel will be on duty the day prior to Sale - and for extra promotion and ease of clearing cattle for clean areas, all cattle to be scratched for ticks on Friday 20th Nov. at the complex. Completed DPI preliminary declaration forms along with waybills are to be presented initially to the D. & G. Livestock office staff. Cattle from clean areas to be exempt from this procedure.
10. Receival time: All cattle for the Sale are to be at the saleyards by **3pm** the day prior and are to be in their allotted pens by **7am** on the day of the Sale for buyers' inspections.
11. A rebate of 2% will be paid to outside agents introducing buyers under the usual conditions. This will be averaged out on a pro rata basis over all cattle sold.
12. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult at all times when in the cattle pens area and are not permitted in the Sale ring or any working area. The Sale Agents and the Kingaroy Shire Council will not be held responsible for any injury inflicted through non-compliance with this order.
13. All cattle to have **NLIS** devices fitted.
14. No bedding straw to be allowed in selling pens or holding pens. All pens are dirt yards and Council requests that no bedding straw be allowed due to clean-out costs.
15. Sale ear tags will be posted to all vendors well in advance of the sale. These are to be inserted in the near ear of all lots offered prior to arrival at the saleyards. It would be most helpful if all cattle could be paint branded prior to arrival.
16. Any sales conducted after the Auction at the Complex, must be put through the Auctioneer's books. If all of individual vendor's females receive a "no bid" or are "passed in" then there will be a charge incurred irrespective, - for yard fees, tick scratching and also dipping if applicable.
